Objective

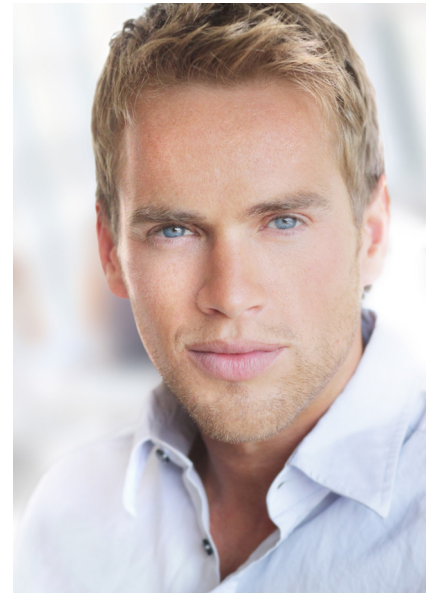
A Salt Lake City specialty pharmaceutical company wanted to place a low testosterone study at a proven site on the Gulf Coast of Florida.
